

Robotics Lettering Guide Salina High School South 2019



Students may letter in Robotics at South High through a point system. A total of 30 points is required for a letter. Points will be awarded based on the following system:

Practice Meeting (Approx. 20 pts possible)	1 each meeting
Recruit a New Member	2
Attend Kickoff	5
Attend Practice Day	5
Attend Game Day	7
Driver on Game Day	5
Spotter on Game Day	5
Marketing Presentation	5
Marketing Booth	5
Battery Czar	2
Pass both the General Rules and Game Rules Quizzes	2
Create the General Rule or Game Rule Quiz	5 each
Completing a Notebook Section - Includes creating the entry, updating the Table of Contents, and necessary appendix additions	5 each
Significant Assistance to a Notebook Entry - ex: completing CAD drawings - Awarded by teacher's discretion	1 each

Procedure to Apply:

In order to apply for a Robotics Letter, the student must complete the application on the back of this sheet. Teachers/coaches will keep track of attendance to verify, but it is ultimately the responsibility of students to record their point totals throughout the season. Applications for lettering are due the week after Game Day each year and will be awarded at the season celebration.

Descriptions should match the points table provided previously.

Daily attendance should be recorded as separate entries with their respective dates. These dates will be verified with the roster sheets collected each meeting.
